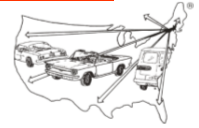

**Cal Expo Autorama Clubhouse update:** The event is from February 15-17, 2019. Corvair Club display move-in dates and times. Wednesday, February 13, 2019, 3:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Rod Shows, the event organizer for the clubhouse, provided set-up passes. Please bring your Rod Shows Invitation and passes. The passes will need to be presented to the Show's gate greeters. All vehicles entered must be on site no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday. All participants will need to go through Gate 12. Once inside the Cal Expo grounds proceed to the Pavilion building near the race track grandstand.

The Corvair Club will meet around 2:30 p.m. at the end of Ethan Way, past Hurley Way in the cul-de-sac parking lot.

Remember to bring cardboard, oil absorbing pads, or metal pan to collect any oil drips from the rear of the engine/transaxle area. Please have less than a ¼ tank of gas, please have a locking gas cap, or tape to cover non-locking gas cap. The car battery will need to be disconnected during the show.

In the mean time, we need to start collecting items for the Autorama show. Decorations/display items will need to be purchased soon.

Both flyers, one from CORSA on the top ten reasons regarding Corvairs and the Club's flyer will need to be printed up to hand out at the show.
