Old Business:

- The Board will review suggested board member definitions/duties at April Club meeting.
- Autorama at CalExpo on May 2, 2025. Sign-ups before April 1. Registration will be through Butch Gardner's Club House, and will be available at the next meeting. Motion APPROVED for the club to subsidize the registration fee of \$125 by \$75 per car for club members so that the cost of participation at Autorama will be \$50 per car. Members will pay the full \$125 registration fee and be reimbursed \$75 by showing up at the event.
- CORSA Convention 2025: Our donation of \$1,500 to the Central Coast club for split sponsorship of the concourse and autocross was very appreciated. The schedule of events is being refined on the CORSA website – note that autocross was moved from Friday to Thursday. We have offered to help with registration and need volunteers. John H. will hold the sign-up sheet. Only CORSA members are eligible to attend the convention. Membership is available at \$20 for six months.

New Business:

- Wes reported that the Modesto Corvair Club has disbanded. A member of that club has a 1966 Corvair Monza coupe for sale. It is a red; has a 140 hp engine, an automatic transmission, and air conditioning; and it runs. It looks decent and has a short list of things to be done. The board has been investigating Brookfields on Madison at Highway 80 in Sacramento and will hold the next board meeting there on March 11 at 6 pm to report back to the membership at the next meeting about any change of location.
- John H. proposed a "Dues Cruise" to encourage members to come out and have some fun and find new members and/or encourage members to pay up.

Tech Presentation:

Chris offered to enlarge diagrams of color-coded wiring systems for inclusion on the
website. Several members advised that the club website has electrical diagrams for late
model and early model Corvairs, located under "RESOURCES." There is a lot of material
available, including shop and repair manuals.


