Meeting Minutes

The April meeting of Classic Corvairs of River City was called to order by Bruce Leonard, President, at 6:55pm.

An additional 6 Corvair owners came by to see the show for a few hours and one owner wants to come next year with his late model convertible. There was one new member who signed up at the show – Travis Fowler. In all, there were 6 vendors selling parts, accessories and signage.

Bruce Leonard concluded the review with the dinner festivities at Outback Steakhouse and thanked everyone for participating in and volunteering for what he called; "one of the best shows". In addition, "thank you's" were given to: Central Coast Corvairs, Santa Clara CORSA, and SF Bay Area CORSA. In fact, SF Bay Area CORSA is looking forward to participating again next year.

Wes Nicholas, Treasurer, gave an brief overview of the club's finances and then proceeded with a detailed breakdown on the finances from the Spring Fling. The show made a significant profit versus the last 2 years. With that news, Bruce Leonard asked for a motion to present MADD with a check. It was moved by Paul Bender and seconded by Chris Medeiros with all members voting 'aye'. Bruce informed the members that a check will be presented to MADD at the May 23rd meeting. Next, Bruce Leonard asked for a motion to present CORSA Preservation Society with a check. It was moved by Paul Bender with a seconded by Leo Scopesi with all members voting 'aye'. Wes Nicholas will send a check in the next couple of days.

The next item on the agenda was presented by Bruce Leonard. It was noted how much time and effort was put forth in preparing for the Spring Fling. In addition to the duties as President, takes Meeting Minutes in lieu of a club Secretary and compiles the monthly newsletter. Bruce also did the graphic designs for this year's Spring Fling, worked with Wes Nicholas on the show's budget, and coordinated with the graphic company in SoCal all of the designs for the T-shirts, dash plaques, awards and flyers. The cake was ordered and delivered to Outback Steakhouse. That effort took about 4 months to complete plus coordinating with the other 3 chapters on the raffle prizes.
