Meeting Minutes: April 24, 2025

Meeting was called to order at 6:37 pm by President John Heiser. The total in attendance was 16, including 2 new members.

Minutes of meeting on March 25, 2025, as presented in the newsletter, were unanimously approved.

President's report by President John Heiser:

- Welcome to new members Curt Thue and Nelson Black, and introduction of members present at the meeting and their classic cars.
- Autorama at CalExpo UPDATE:
 - Move in times available April 30 and May 1 as per instruction in mailed material.
 - For safety and security for the duration of the show, members should have no more than ¼ tank full of gas, and should disconnect the battery. Please also bring a gas pan for use on the pavement and a basic fire extinguisher.

Tech Presentation:

Dean James led a discussion about lifters, recommending that vendors ensure correct lifters for Corvairs and not designed for small block chevrolet engines..

Wes Nicholas led a detailed discussion about carburetors and how to balance them. Due to 60 plus years for these carburetors, you just never know if you have the correct parts in each carburetor you are rebuilding. Wes went into the carburetor venturi cluster since there is at least 3 different variations under one part number and to measure the various openings to insure that you have a matched set. Bob Helt's Rochester H Carburetor book is a great resource in further explaining these measurements. For car engines of different years ('65, '66, '67), the idle jets have different measurements, which can be cleaned with drill bits and/or welding tip cleaners. Harbor Freight has appropriate drill bits between 1.0 and 0.1 mm to fit the idle jets. CORSA Tech Guides Volume 1 and 2 are also great resources on these carburetors when rebuilding them.
